

**HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE  
PROCEDURES**

- The purpose of the Hall Of Fame Committee shall be to perpetuate the name of those who have displayed outstanding ability in the sport of American Ten Pins and or have contributed meritorious service to the reputation and progress of bowling in the area served by Mercer Burlington USBC Bowling Association.
- The Hall Of Fame Committee shall be an official function of the Mercer Burlington Bowling Association and should be determined by annual election.
  - A. Two members of the board.
  - B. Two life members (if association has life members).
  - C. Two Hall Of Fame members already elected.
  - D. An ex-official President is member of the Hall Of Fame committee.

**HALL OF FAME CANDIDATE QUALIFICATION**

A point system will be used to avoid making a selection based on bias or without supporting documentation.

An Individual must accumulate \_\_\_\_\_ points to qualify for induction.

## **NOMINATIONS**

- Any member of the Mercer Burlington Bowling Association may submit a nomination along with the nominee's qualifications and achievements to the President or Association Manger for referral to the Hall Of Fame Committee.
- Nominations for any year should be presented before December 31 of every year.

## **METHOD OF SELECTION**

- The names of the nominees should remain anonymous when conducting a ballot vote.
- Final selection of The Hall Of Fame will consist of two-thirds vote of the Association Board based on the Hall Of Fame Recommendation Committee.
- The selections shall consist of no more than \_\_\_\_\_ nominations per year.
- Nominations not selected in any given year are not automatically included in next year's selections. A new resume must be completed if someone wishes to nominate them again.

## **QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMITTANCE IN THE MBBA USBC HALL OF FAME BOWLING ACHIEVEMENT**

### **QUALIFICATIONS (80% OF BELOW)**

- Applicant must be at least 40 years old
- Applicant must be a member of MBBA for at least 15 years
- Applicant must possess a 3 house league history
- Applicant must have won a county tournament or at least place or show in any event
- Any State Titles held by applicant will be accepted

### **WOMAN'S DIVISION**

- One woman per year who meets the same qualifications

### **BALLOT**

- All applicants will be considered for Hall Of Fame Committee

### **VETERANS**

- Applicants must be at least 60 years of age
- Applicants must be a member of MBBA for at least 15 years over the past 50 years.
- Averages will be considered at time in which applicants were bowling
